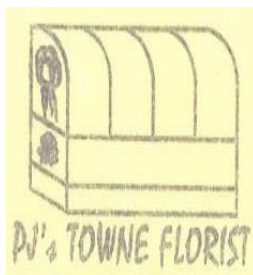

**January 25, 2015**-The last Sunday of January has been set aside by Synodal resolution as Music Scholarship Sunday, which puts special emphasis on the Music Scholarship program of the National United Choirs of the P. N.C.C. It is the Sunday when the choirs, organists, directors and choir members should be recognized for their contributions to the music ministry of our church. It is also the Sunday when we look to the future and identify those that we hope will be part of the music ministry of the church. **FIRST HOLY COMMUNION CLASSES:**



The preparation for first Holy Communion is held on Sundays, after the 11 AM Mass in the parish hall. NEXT CLASSES will be held on Sunday January 25, Feb. 8, 22, March 8, 22, April 12, 26, May 10 –Mother’s Day, May 15 (Friday) – First Holy Communion rehearsal and Confessions at 7 pm, Sunday May 17, 2015 – First Holy Communion celebration at 11 am. Children who are enrolled at second grade and older are eligible to take classes. The Holy Eucharist is Jesus Christ really present under the forms of bread and wine. In the Eucharist, Jesus Christ gives us Himself as a food for our souls. The bread and wine becomes the Body and Blood of our Lord during the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass when the priest says words of consecration which Jesus used during the Last Supper: This is My Body... This is My Blood. (Catechism)

**EPIPHANY PASTORAL VISITATIONS**



– Fr Joseph will be blessing homes during Epiphany Pastoral Visitations. He will call in advance to schedule the time convenient for the family. Normally the blessing of homes takes place from Christmas until the season of Lent. In different parts of the world the Feast of Three Kings is celebrated in a festive parade as the beginning of the Carnival season. There are some customs associated with this feast such as to bake King Cakes or fill a box with fresh grass and hay by children to feed the Wise Men's camels. In Some countries children walk from



house to house and villagers will give almonds, dried figs, nuts, cookies or other good things that they have at home. In Poland the chalk and incense are blessed and, above the door of the home, the letters of Three kings are written "C+M+B+" with the year, to provide protection against illness and misfortune for those within. The letters, with a cross after each one, also stand for a Latin inscription meaning "Christ bless this house." "Christus mansionem benedicat."

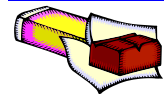
