

The Holy Eucharist is Jesus Christ who is really present under the forms of bread and wine. In the Eucharist, Jesus Christ gives us Himself as a food for our souls. The bread and wine becomes the Body and Blood of our Lord during the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass when the priest says words of consecration which Jesus used during the Last Supper: This is My Body... This is My Blood. (Catechism)

The First Class of preparation for First Holy Communion will be held on Sunday September 18, 2016 after 11 am Mass. Some requirements: Students should be enrolled in 2nd grade or older to participate; Classes 45 are

minutes long (12:15-1pm); Classes are bi-weekly (check bulletin) duration Sept-May; **Students must attend** School of Christian Living classes at 10:10am followed by the Holy Mass at 11am; Parents/Guardians are required to attend Sunday Mass each week with children.
