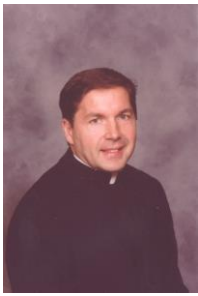

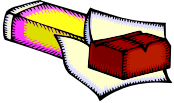

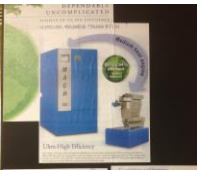

Information for our Youth

"Convo" is held every other summer as a national PNCC youth convention begins. This year it will begin on July 21-25, 2014 at Heidelberg University; Tiffin, OH. This gathering gives the youth of our church a chance to make lifelong friendship with other church members from across the country.



Opportunities are also available for youth to be elected to the Church United Youth Association (UYA) where they represent the youth of the church through their own ministry and with adult members.

Youth Camp (KURS) is held every year in Waymart, Pa. It begins on July 4th and ends on July 12th. Our theme this year is "Miracles." As Christians come together to spend a week at the recreation center, we will focus not only on the miracles within the scriptures and by the hands of Jesus Christ, but those in the world around us.



Lectures will feature views on miracles from bishops, priests, the military, and the medical field. There is an average of 5-7 attendees at a cost of approximately \$220 per person. Ask Fr. 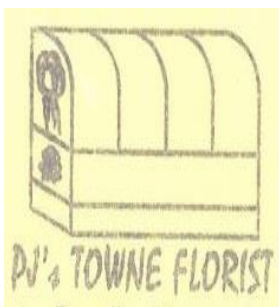
