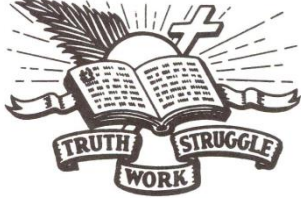

The Holy Eucharist is Jesus Christ who is really present under the forms of bread and wine. In the Eucharist, Jesus Christ gives us Himself as a food for our souls. The bread and wine becomes the Body and Blood of our Lord during the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass when the priest says words of consecration which Jesus used during the Last Supper: This is My Body... This is My Blood. (Catechism)

The First Class of preparation for First Holy Communion will be held on Sunday September 25, 2016 after 11 am Mass.

Some requirements: Students should be enrolled in 2nd grade or older to participate; Classes are 45 minutes long (12:15-1pm); Classes are bi-weekly (check bulletin) duration Sept-May; Students must attend School of Christian Living classes at 10:10am followed by the Holy Mass at 11am; Parents/Guardians are required to attend Sunday Mass each week with children.

OUR LADY OF SORROWS – SEPTEMBER 16. The Sorrowful Mother or Mother of Sorrows (Latin: Mater Dolorosa), and Our Lady of Piety, Our Lady of the Seven Sorrows or Our Lady of the Seven Dolors are names by which the Blessed Virgin Mary is referred to in relation to sorrows in her life. As Mater Dolorosa, it is also a key subject for Marian art in the Catholic Church. The Seven Sorrows of Mary are a popular Roman Catholic devotion. There are devotional prayers which consist of meditation on her Seven Sorrows. The Seven Sorrows (or Dolors) are events in the life of the Blessed Virgin Mary which are a popular devotion and are frequently depicted in art. 1.The Prophecy of Simeon. (Luke 2:34-35) or the Circumcision of Christ. 2.The Flight into Egypt. (Matthew 2:13). 3.The loss of the child Jesus in the Temple. (Luke 2:43-45). 4.Mary meets Jesus on the way to Calvary. 5.Jesus dies on the cross. (John 19:25). 6.Mary receives the body of Jesus in her arms. (Matthew 27:57-59).7.The body of Jesus is placed in the tomb. (John 19:40-42)





The Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross (Sept 14), celebrated every year on September 14, recalls three historical events: the finding of the True Cross by Saint Helena, the mother of the emperor Constantine; the dedication of churches built by Constantine on the site of the Holy Sepulchre and Mount Calvary; and the restoration of the True Cross to Jerusalem by the emperor Heraclius II. But in a deeper sense, the feast also celebrates the Holy Cross as the instrument of our salvation. This instrument of torture, designed to degrade the worst of criminals, became the life-giving tree that reversed Adam's Original Sin when he ate from the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil in the Garden of Eden.
