Please join us for STATIONS OF THE CROSS ON FRIDAY in LENT at 7:15 pm and Good Friday at 3 pm. The tradition of moving around the Stations to commemorate the Passion of Christ began with St. Francis of Assisi and extended throughout the Catholic Church in the medieval period. It is also observed in other Christian Churches. It is most commonly done during Lent, especially on Good Friday.
