

Jesus meets <u>His Mother</u>; 5. <u>Simon of Cyrene</u> carries the cross; 6. Veronica wipes the face of Jesus; 7. Jesus falls the second time; 8. Jesus meets the women of Jerusalem;

9. Jesus falls the third time; 10. Jesus is stripped of His garments; 11. <u>Crucifixion</u>: Jesus is nailed to the cross; 12. Jesus dies on the cross; 13. Jesus' body is removed from the cross; 14. Jesus is <u>laid in the tomb</u>.

This liturgy helps us to meditate on the sufferings of Jesus and better understand his greatest love for us by dying on the cross for our sins.


