INTRODUCTION



My brothers, sisters, today we continue to hear of the early Christian communities as they multiplied and grew. Spreading the Gospel was a risky thing, and they were motivated and fed by their memories of Jesus' powerful words. The familiar Israelite image of the vine in today's Gospel would have been especially reassuring: Despite the physical separation, their deep, ongoing connection to Jesus remained firm. It's the same message for us. Stay close, trust in the source, and keep bearing fruit!


