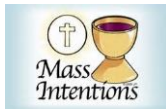

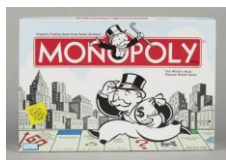
Holy Cross Prayer Shawl Ministry - Do you crochet or knit? Then join us in this new ministry
