

New Parish Project seal-coating and re-striping of parking lot and new Air Condition Unit at Fr. John Slysz Building / Day Care is completed.





The project did cost **\$3,000.00 which was done by** <u>Doctor Driveway Paving</u>. This company is highly recommended.
