INTRODUCTION "Unbind him and let him go." Luke 11:44

My friends, we live in these challenging times due to Coronavirus epidemic. I am sure there are many questions that we have...how long these epidemic restrictions will affect our lives. When can we get back to a normal way of living? How long before we can worship once again in our churches? These are good questions and they can also cause us much anxiety. We must not lose hope but pray and believe that God, the father, Jesus, God's Son and Holy Spirit are with us. Today we begin the Fifth Sunday of Lent and we hear about the story of Martha, Mary and their brother Lazarus. Jesus reminds Martha that her brother, Lazarus will rise again. Today the Lord is asking all of us—Do you believe this? There are little deaths such as ill health, loss of a job, our security or something that meant a lot to us. We have to trust that even in these little deaths, God is with us.


