



Dear Parishioners, Happy Father's Day!

ON SUNDAY JUNE 21 WE CONTINUE TO HAVE REGULARLY SCHEDULED MASSES AT 9 AM AND 11 AM with necessary precautions. You are invited to attend Sunday Mass wearing masks and keeping social distancing. Our pews are prepared for these requirements indicating places where you may sit.

Join either Mass praying for deceased and living fathers on this special weekend. Generally, feel safe and "do not be afraid" as we hear Jesus' words in the Gospel this Sunday.

Purell sanitizer is available to disinfect hands. After careful calculations it was determined that 40 people can be seated in the church with a required 60 inch separation. Families may sit together in the same pew. If there is an overflow of people (which was not the case last Sunday), seating is available in the parish hall. The Mass can be seen and heard on the closed circuit TV.

In concurrence with families we will celebrate the Sacrament of Baptisms that were postponed. The date for children receiving First Holy Communion will be announced after reevaluation with parents.

Coffee hour will be suspended for the time being, however socializing can take place with the 6 foot distancing rule in the parish hall. Priest, deacons and lectors will not wear masks in the sanctuary, however they will wear them before and after leaving the sanctuary.

There will be restrictions on the pew books and the distribution of weekly bulletins.

All activities and fundraisers will be postponed until they are permitted. More information will be provided in upcoming weeks. Do not hesitate to email, call or text if you have any questions.
