

Based on the information recently provided by Governor Phil Murphy, churches have permission to reopen after June 12th with necessary precautions.

ON SUNDAY JUNE 14th. WE WILL HAVE REGULARLY SCHEDULED MASSES AT 9 AM AND 11 AM.

As per the Parish Committee meeting held on May 19<sup>th</sup>, preparations for reopening were discussed.

All parishioners will be required to wear a mask, if you do not have a mask, one will be provided for you. Purell sanitizer will be available to disinfect hands. After careful calculations it was determined that 40 people can be seated in the church with a required 60 inch separation. Families may sit together in the same pew. If there is an overflow of people, seating will be available in the parish hall. The Mass can be seen and heard on the closed circuit TV. Holy Communion can not be distributed yet, therefore the Spiritual Communion Prayer will be recited.

In concurrence with families we will celebrate the Sacrament of Baptisms that were postponed.

The date for children receiving First Holy Communion will be announced after reevaluation with their parents.

Coffee hour will be suspended for the time being, however socializing can take place with the 6 foot distancing rule in the parish hall. Priest, deacons and lectors will not wear masks in the sanctuary, however they will wear them before and after leaving the sanctuary. During the mass two altar servers can be present. In order to keep the distance, the altar servers will ring the bells instead of bringing the wine and water to the priest.

There will be restrictions on the pew books and the distribution of weekly bulletins.

The 11am Live Stream on Facebook will still be available for those who can not attend mass at holycrosswoodlandpark.com

All activities and fundraisers will be postponed until they are permitted.

IF DESIRED, OTHER CHURCHES IN OUR AREA ARE OPEN FOR PRIVATE PRAYERS AND CONFESSIONS.

HOLY CROSS CHURCH WILL BE OPEN ON SUNDAYS FROM 12 NOON TO 1:30 PM AND MONDAY TO FRIDAY FROM 8:30 AM TO 10 AM.
