Dear Parishioners,

ON SUNDAY July 5 WE CONTINUE TO HAVE REGULARLY SCHEDULED MASSES AT 9 AM AND 11 AM with necessary precautions to keep you safe.

You are invited to attend Sunday Mass wearing masks and keeping social distancing. Our pews are prepared for these requirements indicating places where you may sit.

Purell sanitizer is available to disinfect hands. After careful calculations it was determined that 40 people can be seated in the church with a required 60 inch separation. Families may sit together in the same pew. If there is an overflow of people (which was not the case last Sunday), seating is available in the parish hall. The Mass can be seen and heard on the closed circuit TV.

In concurrence with families we celebrate the Sacrament of Baptisms that were postponed in the near future. Coffee hour is be suspended for the time being, however socializing can take place with the 6 foot distancing rule in the parish hall. Priest, deacons and lectors will wear masks before and after leaving the sanctuary.

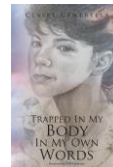
