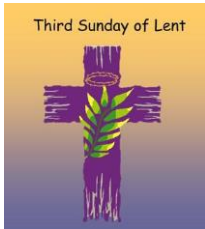

This is My Blood. (Catechism)*

Dear Parishioners, On Wednesday, March 16, 2022 a second donations was made to the Ukrainian American Society in Whippany. This time we delivered a dozen boxes for the people of Ukraine. Also, according to the decision of Parish Committee we donated \$2,625 to the same organization helping Ukrainian people in their time of war. Last week we also donated \$1000 to Samaritan Purse, an organization which is involved in a humanitarian mission



helping Ukraine with food and medical assistance. More monetary donations are coming in. 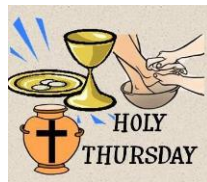
