INTRODUCTION




My friends, sometimes our readings are full of good news; sometimes they abound in hard warnings. Today we are warned that we need to be attentive to the opportunities around us to serve others. It's easy to postpone for another day the steps we need to take. Trusting in God's ultimate mercy is only half the story. Today may be the only time we

have to respond.

We hear about God's care especially for those who are poor. The parable warns us about getting too comfortable and ignoring others. The rich man's problem wasn't just that he had a lot of good things; it was that he didn't care about Lazarus, a poor man suffering right outside his door.
